- Every application will be reviewed by the CPPRF Board on a case by case basis
- All decisions of the CPPRF Board are final.
- Applications must be submitted to the board at least 3 months prior to the course dates.
- The intentions of the Comanche Pool Prairie Resource Foundation are to provide a percentage of enrollment fees for Continuing Education purposes at the discretion of the CPPRF Board.

The CPPRF may pay up to 50% of the total registration/tuition costs with a maximum of \$2000 per applicant.

The applicant must provide to Pool receipts for payment of enrollment fees for the event when submitting scholarship application form.

The CPPRF funds awarded are designated solely for the purposes of the enrollment fee.

All travel and lodging expenses shall be the sole responsibility of the applicant
